#### Topic 2: Introduction of the Green-4-Future project


UPB gave a short overview about the current state of the single IOs before starting with the discussion about them.

Organisational aspects: 36 months project → no possibility for the extending the project duration


Then every partner institution also presented its own institution.



- •The Collaborative Recycling/Reuse Model -BFU; UPB and ISQ






#### **IO3: In Service Training**


